



YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS ELIGIBILITY FACT SHEET

Eligible youth must meet at least one of the criteria shown below:

- Youth has Limited English Proficiency (ESL/ELL students)
- Youth performs at one grade level or more below average or is basic skills deficient
- Youth is enrolled in an alternative learning program
- Youth has a physical, mental, emotional or learning disability*
- Youth has an IEP*
- Family receives public assistance
- Youth is eligible for FREE school lunch
- Youth is or was chemically dependent
- Youth is receiving Group Home Services
- Youth is a foster child
- Youth is an actual or potential school dropout
- Youth is a teen parent/pregnant
- Youth is a juvenile offender
- Youth is homeless/runaway

**Special needs youth must be able to understand and carry out basic instructions and be able to work safely and effectively in a 1:8 staff to student ratio when working on a crew.*

Additional Criteria

Males 18 and older must be registered with the Selective Service before submitting an application to work in our government-funded program. They can register at <http://sss.gov>

All youth must include a copy of their social security card with their completed application. Youth who are not U.S. citizens must include a copy of their R.A. card.

Youth must also meet age and residency requirements. We can only employ youth ages 14 - 21 who RESIDE in Washington, Dakota or suburban Hennepin County.
